 - Clover Lance (Descaler)
 - Clover Swift (Furniture Polish)
 - Clover Dazzle (Stainless Steel Polish)
 - Clover UltraExtreme (Disinfectant)
 - Method Wood Cleaner (Natural wood cleaner)
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Hazards & Controls

Product	Hazards	Controls & PPE
UBIK	Skin/eye irritation	Use diluted; ventilate; gloves; eye protection optional
STC	Corrosive; skin/eye irritation	Use diluted; ventilate; gloves; eye protection optional
Lance	Corrosive descaler	Dilute carefully; ventilate; gloves, safety goggles, apron when diluting/large use
Swift	Solvent vapours	Use sparingly; ventilate; gloves; eye protection optional
Dazzle	Solvent exposure	Apply with cloth; ventilate; gloves; eye protection optional
UltraExtreme	Skin/eye irritation; respiratory hazard	Dilute correctly; ventilate; gloves, eye protection, apron
Method Wood Cleaner	Mild irritant	Use as directed; ventilate; gloves recommended; eye protection optional

Splash Risk and Use of Trigger Spray Bottles

When using trigger spray bottles containing corrosive or irritant chemicals:

- Always point the spray downwards toward surfaces below eye level to reduce splash risk.
- Under these conditions, the risk of chemical splashing into eyes is generally low.

- Despite this, accidental splashes may still occur due to spray rebound or handling errors.
 - For small quantities of UBIK, STC, Lance, Swift — typically diluted or applied to cloth — and when used in well-ventilated areas with consistent safe spray direction and no history of splash incidents, eye protection may be considered optional.
 - In all cases, safety goggles must be made available and remain readily accessible, and staff must be trained to use them if splash risk increases or individual preference requires.
 - For larger volumes, dilution tasks, or when working in confined spaces, wearing safety goggles is mandatory.
 - Users must maintain safe spray technique and use PPE appropriately.
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General Safety & Storage

- Keep chemicals out of reach of children.
 - Do not discharge chemicals into drains.
 - Store chemicals in correctly labelled plastic containers, preferably in cupboards inaccessible to children.
 - Storage at eye level may be unavoidable; wear safety goggles when handling corrosives stored at eye level (e.g., descaler).
 - For leaking containers, store leak side up to prevent spills.
 - Inspect containers regularly and report damage.
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Usage Instructions

- Always read full product instructions before use.
 - Use small quantities for UBIK, STC, Lance, Swift — typically applied to cloth or diluted.
 - For customer-supplied domestic products, ensure full instructions are available and customers avoid chemical mixing.
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Emergency Procedures

- **Skin contact:** Rinse immediately with water; remove contaminated clothing.
 - **Eye contact:** Flush with water for at least 15 minutes; remove contact lenses if possible; seek medical help if irritation persists.
 - **Inhalation:** Move to fresh air; get medical help if symptoms occur.
 - **Spills:** Wear PPE; contain and clean spill immediately.
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Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Disposable gloves for general cleaning (single use per clean).
 - Rubber gloves for handling concentrates and diluting chemicals.
 - Disposable aprons when diluting or using large volumes.
 - Safety goggles mandatory for corrosive products or splash risk (see spray bottle guidance).
 - Respiratory masks available for non-light chemical use or per individual need.
 - Wash hands thoroughly after sessions and glove changes.
 - Eye washes provided to each team member.
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Additional Controls

- Ensure good ventilation in all areas where chemicals are used.
