Workers mainly work remotely and alone	For this reason personal first aid kits will be issued. Workers will be encouraged to ensure they have mobile phones which remain credited for use.		
Is the work location remote from emergency medical services?	All locations are adjacent to a suitable road network in which medical services can access the location worked at. Team members will be advised to ensure they know the address at which they are working Addresses can be obtained from the Appointed Person		
Do any of your employees work at sites occupied by other employers?	Workers are expected to make themselves aware of any additional first aid arrangements are provided at location. Customers who offer other first aid provisions are expected to clearly display the location of their kits, accident book and registered first aiders/ appointed persons.		
Do you have enough provision to cover for your first-aiders or appointed persons when they are absent?	Each worker is solely responsible for themselves as far as first aid provisions go and to ensure they are replenished from the Appointed Person. The Appointed Person will be responsible to ensuring this is adhered to and that each worker does have suitable first aid provisions.		
Do members of the public visit your premises?	As we operate at our customer premises it is assumed that the customer provides adequate provisions for their visitors, our workers are not expected to provide first aid to other people.
